

CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY

If you need to withdraw from one of our courses prior to the start of the course, we will provide you with a full refund. If you are five class sessions or fewer into the course and are unhappy with it for any reason, you can still receive a full refund or credit.

Refunds beyond the end of the first five class sessions are pro-rated based on the effective date of your withdrawal and the amount you have already paid.

For students enrolled in the full-time (day) Web Developer Bootcamp or Front-end Web Designer/Developer Bootcamp, tuition refunds are pro-rated as follows:

- a. You can receive a refund of up to 75% of the full course tuition if the effective date of your withdrawal falls between the beginning of the second week of class and the end of the third week of class.
- b. You can receive a refund of up to 25% if the effective date of your withdrawal falls between the beginning of the fourth week of class and the end of the sixth week of class.
- c. After six weeks, no refunds will be given.

For students enrolled in the Part-time (evening) Web Developer Bootcamp, tuition refunds are pro-rated as follows:

- a. You can receive a refund of up to 75% of the full course tuition if the effective date of your withdrawal falls between the sixth class session and the fifteenth class session.
- b. You can receive a refund of up to 25% if the effective date of your withdrawal falls between the sixteenth class session and the thirty-sixth class session.
- c. After the thirty-seventh class session, no refunds will be given.

For students enrolled in the part-time (evening) Data Science Bootcamp, tuition refunds are pro-rated as follows:

- a. You can receive a refund of up to 75% of the full course tuition if the effective date of your withdrawal falls between the sixth class session and the twelfth class session.
- b. You can receive a refund of up to 25% if the effective date of your withdrawal falls between the thirteenth class session and the twenty-eighth class session.
- c. After the twenty-ninth class session, no refunds will be given.

The effective date of your withdrawal will be considered the date we receive your written notice. Written notice of withdrawal must be sent via email to the NSS President or his designee. In the event of an unofficial withdrawal (see Attendance Policy in the NSS catalog), your date of withdrawal will be considered the last day of class attendance. NSS will refund your tuition within 15 days of receiving your written notice.

For a student who cannot complete one or more classes because NSS discontinued such class(es) during a period of enrollment for which the student was charged, NSS will refund the sum of all amounts paid by or on behalf of the student for such class(es).
